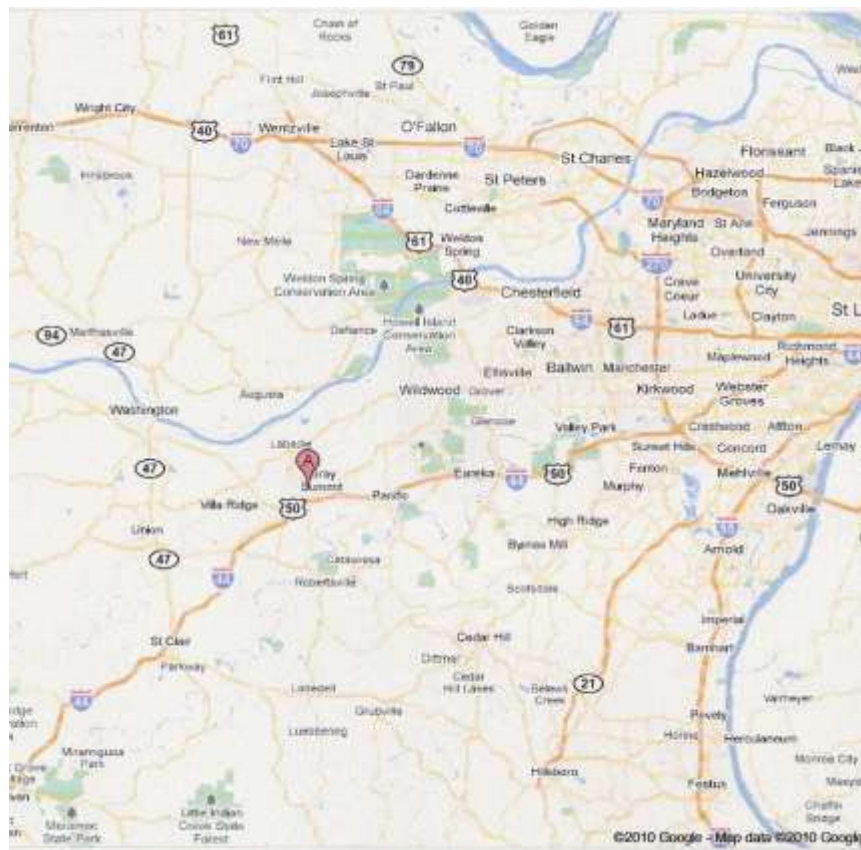

All Purina prizes not awarded in the ring must be picked up during the event at the Hospitality Center; presentation of the winning ribbon is required. Purina reserves the right to make substitutions of equal or greater value in the event a specific listed prize is not available.

High in Trial will be determined as follows. For dogs that have scores of 100 in the Master/Excellent classes, the actual seconds under standard course time to the hundredth will be combined from both Regular Master/Excellent Standard and Regular Master/Excellent JWW classes, and similarly from Preferred Master/Excellent and Preferred Master/Excellent JWW classes. The poodle from each division with the highest points (seconds) will be HIT. HIT Overall will be awarded to the poodle with the highest points from Regular and Preferred. **High in Trial Junior**, **High in Trial Champion**, and the **Peabody Award** only qualifying scores from the Standard classes will be used. In the case of a tie, the winner will be determined by the highest amount of seconds under SCT.

High in Trial Junior, the handler must have a valid AKC Junior Handler number.

High Scoring Open and **High Scoring Novice** Dog from the Standard classes will be determined by qualifying scores. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by the highest amount of seconds under SCT.

There will be an awards ceremony following Master/Excellent JWW.

Peabody Award

The Poodle Club of America Foundation and Janet Lange Moses offer a Sterling Silver Tray Challenge Trophy in memory of MACH2 Reignon Dassin Mr. Peabody CDX RA MXC MJG MJP4 MJPB PAX NFP. This will be awarded to the highest scoring Miniature Poodle in Preferred Agility classes at the National Specialty only. For permanent possession, to be won three times by the same owner/owners but not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive shows.

Mentors Needed

Handlers who are attending their first ever Poodle Club of America National Specialty Show for agility will be matched with an exhibitor who has experienced PCA before. The goal of the program is to allow new exhibitors the opportunity to experience PCA without some of the stress that accompanies a new show site.

Exhibitors who are flying to Missouri may also register for the program and be matched with a mentor. The goal of this portion of the program is to help provide supplies that an exhibitor may not be able to bring on the airline flight, such as a cooler or chair.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all Poodles fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. **Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials except as provided in the AKC Regulations.**

Notice to Exhibitors

The Trial Secretary is not responsible for Emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 24 hours, please call the Trial Secretary by telephone.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee(s).

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fees for a bitch in season or for an injured dog, only upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim before judging commences.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Poodle Club of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must include their AKC # on the entry form. Please include only AKC titles on your entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors.

No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Poodle Club of America, their Board, Members, and Nestle Purina Farm, it's owners' and employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event..

Poodle Club of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials

Trial Information

- Electronic Timing will be used at these trials.
- Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion..
- The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space.
- Food service is available at the trial site.
- **Outside Food and Drink is not allowed in the building.**
- Bring your own chairs and water for your dog.
- Mats must be used under metal crates and any other item that may leave an impression in the rubber flooring.
- No Smoking is allowed in the building
- Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Move-ups

Pre Entry Move ups CLOSE at 6:00 pm Central, Monday April 13, 2020

It is recommended that Move-ups be sent by email to trial secretary, list owner name, dogs call name and class to be moved to. An email confirmation will be sent of processed Move Up.

Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
