- Should you not have a Smartphone or other Electronic Device that will allow you to utilize Health Pass, you will need to bring your proof of vaccination (vaccination card, medical record, etc.)

Once your vaccination record has been uploaded to the platform, it can typically take up to 30 minutes for your status to be verified. We encourage all attendees to complete this process at least 24 hours before the event.

UPDATED COVID INFORMATION **Important - Please Read**

DUE TO THE INCREASE IN VARIANTS OF COVID, PCA negotiated with Purina Farms in order to be able to hold our National Specialty, indoors and with spectators, under the following conditions:

ALL ATTENDEES will have to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, with any vaccine approved by the U.S., Canada or your home country worldwide. People are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's vaccine. If you do not meet these requirements, regardless of your age, you are NOT fully vaccinated. The only EXCEPTION to this requirement is for those children, 12 years old and under, who are unable to be vaccinated due to applicable law.

FACE COVERINGS WILL BE MANDATORY AT ALL TIMES FOR EVERYONE, AGE 5 AND OLDER, NO EXCEPTIONS, WHEN INDOORS. Masks will be strongly encouraged outdoors, especially in group settings.

WHEN ENTERING PURINA FARMS, at the gate, you must show a valid proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19, along with valid ID. Those entering will be provided a wrist band that must be worn at all times.

ANY VIOLATION OF THE ABOVE PROTOCOLS will result in immediate expulsion from the show grounds and an Event Committee hearing for disciplinary action.

IMPORTANT - TRANSFERS of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch. 11 Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show. TRANSFERS by Junior Handlers from Novice to Open Class or from the Open to Master Class MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show. SUBSTITUTIONS of Junior Showmanship dogs must be made prior to the judging of the class at the show. TRANSFERS OF DOGS IN OBEDIENCE/RALLY CLASSES (Ch. 1 Section 16 of Obedience Regulations) The request for transfers must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers for Obedience may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

NOTICE

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEE.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. GENERAL INFORMATION & SHOW RULES

There will be NO space for unentered dogs.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging. Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is judged. The Show-giving Club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash except when being judged or in the exercising ring.

Declination of Entries - The Poodle Club of America, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Poodle Club of America, Inc. or any official thereof.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.
